

Peninsula Tennis Club Standing Rules

1. Prior to occupying a court, all players must check in at the reservation desk, and have a Peninsula Tennis Club membership and General Waiver verified (or purchase a daily permit).
2. Court time is subject to availability. Using the court reservation system is highly encouraged. Singles play is limited to one hour; doubles to 90 minutes. Players are not guaranteed a particular court. Using automated means such as automated computer scripts to make reservations on the Court Reservation system is unfair to other club members, will not be tolerated, and will subject the offender to discipline up to and including cancellation of the offenders PTC membership.
3. It is considered unbecoming conduct if any member or nonmember, while on the property of the Peninsula Tennis Club, engages in (A) abusive display of temper, (B) loud abusive or threatening language, (C) profanity, (D) obscene language or gestures, (E) racquet throwing, or (F) behavior that could jeopardize the safety of persons or cause damage to property. Any of the above infractions may be considered as grounds for ejection from the PTC property and/or cancellation of PTC membership.
4. If players are not present 5 minutes after a court reservation begins, the reservation desk may give the reserved court to others waiting for a court. Players are encouraged to contact the reservation desk if they know they will be late so that the court can be held.
5. After reserved court time has concluded, those players who reserved the court may contact the reservation desk to make a subsequent reservation on that court or another available court.
6. Players on league teams representing PTC must have a current PTC membership or have paid the League Fee. Team captains must provide roster and home match dates for verification before the season begins.
7. Only non-marking tennis shoes are allowed on the courts.
8. No solicitation of tennis services or food services, including but not limited to selling/buying of tennis racquets, tennis paraphernalia, restringing of racquets, or tennis instruction shall be allowed on PTC premises without prior approval of PTC. Violators will be subject to discipline up to and including dismissal from PTC.
9. Only club members, day-pass holders, instruction participants, school team players/audience, league match competitors, and pro shop patrons have access to the clubhouse, including the restroom.
10. No music is allowed on the tennis courts other than that approved and supervised by the Board or teaching professionals during clinics and special events.
11. Dogs are allowed at PTC, but should be kept on leashes and under the control of the owner at all times.
